Emergency Procedures

In case of an emergency at the **Harris Plant** we will follow either of the established procedures:

Taking Shelter in Place /Lockdown:

Do not come to school to pick your child. Stay inside until local radio and television reports it's safe to go outside. We will also remain indoors and will wait until you can safely come to pick up your child.

If Asked to Evacuate:

- 1. We will follow the **evacuation route** established for **subzone E**, and will relocate at **SANDERSON HIGH-SCHOOL**.
- 2. Unless you declined in writing, your child will be administered potassium iodide at the recommendation of state health officials.

Please make sure you're enrolled in our **REMIND** cell phone message system.

Financial Agreement: We believe that our school will keep students by its own merit, so our families are never asked to sign any enrollment or financial contracts - We offer monthly tuition payment options, and discounts for those who commit to prepaying 3, 6 or 10-12 months. If our families have to leave the school, <u>we kindly ask for a</u> <u>30 days written notice.</u> Any "in-advance" prepaid tuition will be fully reimbursed minus related discounts and credit card processing fees when applicable.

Make-up days and Planned Vacations Policy Our school has a budget and attendance permitting, discretionary, make-up days policy. Please check with us as this is a case-by-case situation.

Tuition Due date and payment form: Tuition is owed in full on the 1st of the month, it can be paid any day of the month with no late fees. Check or cash is the preferred payment method but we accept most credit cards.

Sick Child Policy

Please follow these guidelines and if your child has any of these symptoms, **please keep them home**:

- Fever within the last 24 hours
- Excessive wheezing or coughing.
- First 2 days of a cold, especially if the child is uncomfortable or has a runny nose with
- yellow/green mucous or a persistent cough.
- Rash (not heat or allergy related).
- Diarrhea, three runny stools in a row.

If you find out that your child has a communicable disease, please let us know so we can notify other parents about the possible exposure.

Ask yourself this important question...if your child is healthy, would you want him/her playing with another child that has your child's symptoms? If the answer is no, **please** do not bring him/her to school. Thank you for your consideration!!

Toys and "Blankies"

Children may bring toys, blankies and "favorite things" to school, provided they are clean and non-violent. **NO weapons please!** Please note we can't take responsibility if toys get lost or broken; and may sometimes have to put the toy away in your child's cubby .

NO PEANUTS / NO TOBACCO POLICY

We are a PEANUT FREE program, peanuts are not allowed at school in any form or contained in any food.

Smoking or use of tobacco products is forbidden in our premises including outside our doors. Clothing or belongings exposed to tobacco smoke or products are not allowed in the school.

Please notify us in writing of any other allergies!!!

Drop off and Pick Up Procedures:

Depending on car volume and to better serve you, we may assign a staggered schedule or front/back door drop off and pick up. Since we don't asses late pick-up fees, we greatly appreciate timely pick-up of children.

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
